Why fundraise?

The Boundary Waters is America's most visited Wilderness, but it's threatened by sulfide-ore copper mining. By starting your own fundraiser, you can help protect clean water, wildlife, and adventure for generations to come.

You don't need to be an expert—your love for the Boundary Waters is the most powerful tool you have.



How it works:

- 1. **Sign-up:** Create your personal fundraising page in minutes.
- 2. **Set a goal:** Choose a fundraising goal that excites you and motivates your community.
- 3. **Make it yours:** Personalizing your page is quick and easy. Use this space to tell your story and share why you care.
- 4. **Spread the word:** Share it with your friends, family, coworkers, neighbors, and paddling buddies.
- Protect the Wilderness: Every dollar donated goes towards permanently protecting the Boundary Waters.
